



Annual Governance Statement for the Governing Body of EP Collier Community Primary School for the 2018/19 academic year

This document sets out how the Governing Body (GB) of EP Collier School has delivered its statutory obligations during the last academic year. A comprehensive attendance record of all governors is included.

In accordance with the Government's requirement for governing bodies, the 3 core strategic functions of EP Collier's GB are:

- 1. Ensuring clarity of vision, ethos and strategic direction;**
- 2. Holding the head teacher to account for the educational performance of the school and its pupils;**
- 3. Overseeing the financial performance of the school and making sure its money is well spent.**

Governance arrangements	<p>The Governing body (GB) was incorporated under an Instrument of Government effective from 1 September 2015 and consists of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 2 elected Parent Governors• 1 Local Authority Appointed Governor• 1 elected Staff Governor• 5 Co-Opted Governors• Head Teacher• Associate members including the Deputy Head and School Business Manager, and others as required. <p>Current details of the governing body can be found on the school website.</p>
Attendance record of governors	<p>Governors have good attendance at meetings with no inquorate meetings. The appendix below provides details of individual governors' attendance at meetings.</p>
The work that we have done on our committees and in the governing body	<p>The GB focused on delivery of the strategic development plan through various operational initiatives driven by the school's leadership team with appropriate challenge from the GB. Delivery of this oversight was largely through committees focused on academic standards, personnel matters, and finance.</p>



	<p>Individuals putting themselves forward as potential governors join as Associate Members of the GB such that they can have a full understanding of the requirements before becoming full governors. Associate members take a full part in the GB but do not vote.</p> <p>The GB has focused on three areas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Implementation of a strategic plan that informs the school's operational plans and is designed to improve educational outcomes for all children at the school, irrespective of background and prior attainment.• Holding the school leadership team to account for the progress and attainment of each cohort.• Supporting the School Business Manager in designing and managing a budget. Budgets are stretched and the GB works with the senior leadership team in setting priorities. <p>To improve performance individual governors have invested in their own professional development both by relevant training and by building links with other GBs.</p>
Future plans for the governors	<p>The GB will retain focus on delivering the strategic plan whilst holding school leaders, at all levels, to account for educational outcomes. The GB will continue to review how cooperation and collaboration with other schools in the Reading Local Authority area and wider afield can help improve educational outcomes for children both at EP Collier and, where appropriate, other community schools.</p>
