	Welsh cake a traditional small flat cake filled with dried fruit such as sultanas and raisins. What would you use as an alternative fruit?		Trifle traditionally made with layers of sponge, jelly, fruit, custard and cream but there are variations around the world (e.g. Tiramisu in Italy). What versions are you familiar with or can you invent?

To make this event a success we ask that every family bring a dish to be shared on the buffet tables. Please bring your dish to the school office by 3.00 pm on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> June. Please do not bring anything containing nuts. Refreshments will be provided.

Parents are required to accompany pupils to this event and everyone is welcome to dress up in traditional clothes of their own country or red, white and blue to represent to the colours of the UK flag.

We will have three short performances from some of our pupils in Lower Key Stage Two, this will include Country dancing, Bollywood dancing and the amazing synchronized swimming routine from their Easter Performance. If you would like to send in any videos of your child/children performing traditional dances from around the world for us to put on our Facebook page as a celebration of our community please do!
