Hair accessories such as slides, ribbons, bobbles etc. should be fairly simple and should be in school colours.

The wearing of nail polish and make-up is actively discouraged. Please tie back long hair.

Parents are asked to ensure that all items are labelled clearly with their child's name.

For safety reasons we ask that the children do not wear jewellery in school, however modest items of religious significance are permitted. If your child wishes to wear stud earrings they are to be removed for P.E. lessons where possible. If this is not possible parents are asked to provide tape so that their child can cover their earrings during P.E.
