They can help you to:

- ✓ gather the information required for an Education, Health and Care assessment and plan
- ✓ understand the Local Offer
- ✓ understand personal budgets and other aspects of the process
- ✓ contact the Information Advice and Support (IAS) Service for general SEN support (formerly Parent Partnership)
