Art and design - Our Beautiful World Georgia O'Keefe—abstract pictures of nature

In this unit the children will:

- Record and explore ideas from first hand observation, experience and imagination
- Use a variety of drawing tools; pencils, crayons, pastels, felt tips, charcoal, ball point pens, chalk
- Begin to explore the use of line, shape, pattern and colour in drawing
- Paint with different brush sizes and types for an intended effect
- Mix and match paint colours to artefacts and objects
- Mix secondary colours – shades and tones
- Experiment with creating abstract pictures in a range of media from real life objects
- Create their own depiction of a flower or plant using media of their choice as a final piece
