Abbey Ruins

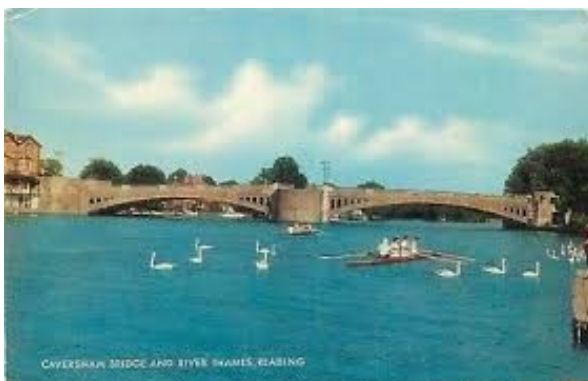
Madjeski Stadium
