In this unit the children will:

- Explore which people in their lives love and care for them
- Think about what these people do to make them feel loved and cared for
- Explore what differences there may be between different families
- Talk about features of family life and the things they do and enjoy with their families

Key Vocabulary

- **Same** - exactly alike; not at all different
- **Different** -not the same
- **Individual** -single, separate, or different from others
- **Similar** -being almost the same as somebody else
- **Family** - All of the people related to you by blood or marriage
- **Group** - A collection of people that are in one place or who have things in common
- **Belong** – to be a member of something



Key Knowledge

- We belong to lots of different groups such as class, school, family, sports clubs, brownies
- We all have different people who love and care for us
- All families are different but share common features
- It is important to tell someone (like a teacher) if something about their family makes them feel un-
